# Product Offering & Origin Profile

Bugisu washed Arabica green coffee from the volcanic slopes of Mount Elgon, Eastern Uganda.

## 1. Product Offering

Export-grade Bugisu washed Arabica green coffee sourced from Eastern Uganda. Produced on the volcanic slopes of Mount Elgon, this coffee is prepared for international trade and presented in commercially recognised grade categories. This catalogue sets out the principal technical parameters, quality profile, available grades, and supply terms for buyer consideration.

## 2. Origin Profile

Sourced from the Bugisu sub-region of Eastern Uganda, this Arabica is produced under highland conditions shaped by Mount Elgon's volcanic soils, elevation, and climate. These factors support good bean formation and a cup profile noted for brightness, clarity, and floral character. It is suited to quality-driven export markets seeking clean East African Arabica for roasting, blending, or direct origin purchasing.

### 3. Processing Specification

Fully washed. Ripe cherries are washed with clean water and dried on raised sunbeds for controlled, even moisture reduction. This supports cup cleanliness, flavour clarity, and sound physical preparation for export.

### Lot Preparation & Quality Control

Following drying, the coffee is graded and sorted by size and density to improve lot uniformity and minimise variation across shipment volumes. Each lot is inspected prior to sampling or sale. Buyer-specific cupping is available on request.

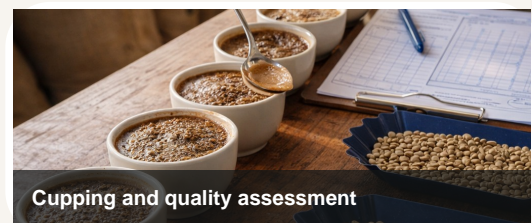
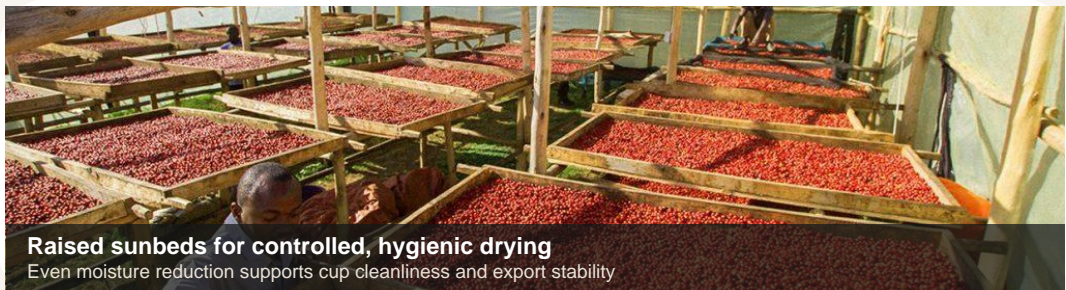

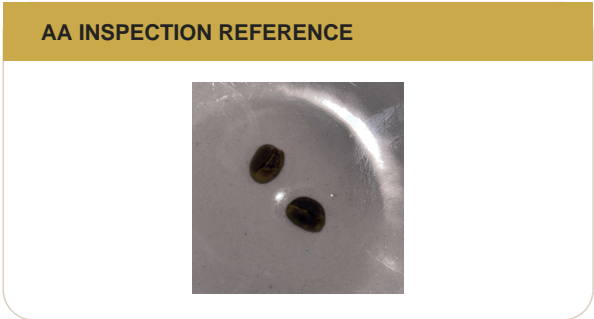
